

Privacy Stand*



Sometimes, a little privacy is all that is needed to help stay focused and get things done! To get some privacy, we make a lightweight stand out of corrugated plastic and tablecloth clips.

Parts: 1 sheet of 2' x 3' corrugated plastic;
2 metal table cloth clips.

1) Two score marks (partial cuts) have been made to a precut sheet of corrugated plastic board. These score marks separate the board into three panels. Bend the plastic board at the scores by lining up each score with a table edge. Push down on the panel that is off the table and fold back.



2) There are two table cloth clips that hold the privacy stand upright. Place each clip on the center panel near the score marks.



3) That's all there is to it! Now you can finally get some privacy!
